Dear 2017-2018 LHS Band Students and Parents,

I hope this letter finds everyone doing well and ready for a great year in the Lewisville Band program. After a successful 2016-17 year at LHS, we are looking forward to next year with great anticipation. As you look forward to the summer, enjoy some welcomed rest and continue to practice your instrument as there will be show music to pass off when you arrive at Band Camp. This is the **final communication** you will receive from the Band Staff, so please take note of the enclosed **dates** and **times**. Also, keep your eye on the Band website at www.lewisvillehsband.com and watch your email for the latest updates. As the new year approaches, we are anticipating many exciting events and opportunities.

All rehearsals for Band Camp will take place on the LHS Main campus. These are exciting times and I challenge you to be ready for a great year.

To continue, our production for the 2017 – 2018 is titled “Imagine”. Mr. Tim Darbonne has returned as our Visual Designer for a 3rd year and will again be writing the drill for our Contest Show this year. Steve Vento will be joining our team for a 2nd year to write our Contest Show Music. We are very excited to have these two gentlemen as part of our design team. The show proves to be a very exciting package for us!! As of today, we have received all of the music and will begin work on it very soon. If you are a new Freshman, you will receive your music at the Mini Camp on June 5th. If not, your section leader will be in touch with you to get the music to you. So get ready!! It’s going to be a great year!! I look forward to seeing all of you in the Fall. Students must have marching show music memorized before reporting for Band Camp on August 1st. Additional music will be given to students at Band Camp (traditional music). We will be attending two local contests this Fall (to be announced later), as well as the UIL Region Contest and the UIL Area Contest. The specific dates for these contests are listed on the calendar at the end of this letter.

This year is our out-of-state Spring Trip year. The Spring Trip will be to Chicago, IL on Memorial Day weekend in May of 2018. The Spring Trip is not mandatory, but is Optional as there is an additional cost for the trip (over and above Band Fees). The cost of the trip to Chicago is \$690.00. The Trip Commitment Form will be handed out when we return in August. Commitment Form and Deposit (\$150.00) will be due on September 1st. The 2018 Spring Trip Deposit (Form and Deposit) will reserve a spot for each student planning to attend the Spring Trip. More details (including the Spring Trip payment schedule) will be coming in the days ahead.

An important note: **Once the Trip Deposit is made, ALL Band Fees must be “Paid in Full” before money will be applied to the any Spring Trip.**

The LHS Band wears formal concert attire for our concerts. Students are to purchase a dress for females or a tuxedo for males at a cost of \$90. An option for used dresses and tuxedos may be available at Registration – watch yahoo group this summer for details. Returning band members will not need to purchase new concert attire unless your student has out-grown their old attire. We will size the students in their classes in October and place one order for all students at that time. We will make announcements in their classes as the sizing times approach.

In addition, if your school-owned instrument is not in working order, you must take it to Music and Arts Center this summer to have it repaired before Band Camp. LISD covers the costs for any “normal” repairs for school-owned instruments per the LISD Rental Contract. Music and Arts Center is located next to Cristina’s Restaurant on FM 3040 close to Vista Ridge Mall and their telephone number is (972) 315-8400. **Please make sure all instruments are in good working order for Band Camp** (both personal and school-owned instruments). Don’t wait until the last minute to repair your instrument as Music and Arts Center is quite busy during the summer (They are currently on a 2-4 week back-log in repairing instruments).

As we know, it costs money to run a Band Program of this size and magnitude. If you know of businesses (individual and corporate) or alumni that would be willing to support the Band program, please let us know. This sponsorship process will help keep the Band fees down. We will continue to raise funds through our traditional events (like the Playathon) and sales (Pies) that will go directly to the Booster Budget in an effort to reduce your band fees for the 2017-2018 year. We are always looking for new fundraising ideas. If you have ideas for fundraising, please contact one of the Vice Presidents for Fundraising with your ideas.

So that all are aware of the costs pertaining to Band for the 2017-2018 year, the costs are listed on the next page followed by the payment schedule. Please understand that if financial assistance or an alternate payment plan is needed, please communicate with our Booster President. There is Financial Assistance available through the Booster Organization to help with Band fees. Please contact the Booster President for an application. Contact information is on the Band website. **We are here to help!!!** However, we can’t help if we don’t know help is needed.

Our largest and most important fundraiser is the Concession Stand, which we run for all Goldsmith Stadium football games. This Fall, we will again be partnering with the LHS Cheerleaders to run the Concession stands. We will manage all Concessions and the Cheerleader Boosters will be providing “work force” to assist with the process. This opportunity helps us raise a substantial amount of money that in turn, greatly helps to reduce the amount of fees charged to students. It is expected that at least one parent of every family will sign up and work to help in this important endeavor. We will again use the Section Parent process. Sign-up sheets for the Concession Stand will be at Registration. More information will be forthcoming very soon.

The fees for the 2017-2018 year are as follows:

Band Fee: \$300

***Band Shoes (needed for **ALL** Band members): \$40

Maintenance Fee (for all School Owned Instruments): \$100

Tuxedo / Dress (for all new Band members): \$90

The Band Fee will continue to include Region Audition Fees and Solo/Ensemble Entry and Accompanists Fees – which in turn reduces your additional out-of-pocket expenses. The budget, showing the breakdown of costs for the Band Fee, was addressed, voted on, and approved at the May 23rd Band Booster meeting. If you were unable to attend the meeting and would like a copy of the 2017-2018 Budget, feel free to email Mrs. Denise Duncan, Booster President to receive a copy. Contact information is on the Band website – www.lewisvillehsband.com.

The payment schedule for non-Spring Trip students is as follows. As in previous years, we will ask for the first payment of the Band Fee at Registration. You may begin making payments during the summer if you choose. Summer payments should be sent to the PO Box (on the website).

1st payment - \$ 100 of the Band Fee (BF) plus \$40 (Band shoes) – July 22
(Band Registration)

2nd payment - \$100 BF plus \$100 (Maintenance Fee, if applicable)–Aug 30

3rd payment - \$50 BF plus \$90 (Tux/Dress, if applicable) – Sept 30

4th payment - Last \$50 of the Band fee – October 30

All Spring Trip payments for the 2018 Spring Trip will be made according to that payment schedule. Following that payment schedule will ensure your Band Fees will be met first. If an alternate Spring Trip payment is needed, please contact our LHS Band Booster President.

Individual payments (such as check, cash or money order) are applied directly to your individual accounts. Please remember – financial assistance is available for Band Fees (not Spring Trip costs) for any student in need. If you need an alternative payment schedule, one can be arranged. **We can't help if we don't know help is needed. Please communicate with Mrs. Denise Duncan (Booster President) or me. All information is kept in strict confidence between you, me, and Mrs. Duncan. Money should never be a reason for missing out on participating in the LHS Band.**

Please be reminded that according to IRS guidelines, all **fundraised** monies are spread equally across the entire Band program (unlike individual payments which go to your individual accounts). The average expected annual Fundraised dollars for this season have already been applied toward this year's Band Fees. This is also why participation by all Band students in all Band fundraisers is expected.

Any Fundraised dollars over and above the anticipated amount will be applied to each individual student's Band Fee first, beginning with the October 30th payment and working backward from there to September 30th, then August 30th, then to the July 22nd payment. Once those fees are satisfied, we will then apply fundraised dollars to the other payments such as LISD Maintenance Fee, Shoes and Tux / Dress. **Money for the Spring Trip will be applied to your account once all other fees are paid and your account is in good standing.**

If you have questions or are confused about the process and payment schedule, please communicate with Mrs. Duncan (Booster President) or me. We will be glad to help. **I say again, we are here to help, but we cannot help if we don't know help is needed. Please communicate with us.**

YAHOO GROUPS: The Band Staff and Band Booster Organization frequently issue updated schedule and event information via the internet through the product known as YAHOO GROUPS. Yahoo Groups is a means to better communicate to the parents and students of the LHS Band. The Booster Board creates, monitors, and sends emails to registered LHS Band families via the broadcasting feature of Yahoo Groups. You do not need to have a Yahoo email account to do this. It is not a "junk mail" service and your address will not given to other organizations. This is strictly for communication to our Band families. If your family has not registered for Yahoo Groups, please do so at your earliest convenience. You may register on the Band website. The process is quite simple and the information is extremely important. If you need assistance, please contact Mrs. Duncan. Her contact information is on the Band website.

Saturday, July 22: Band Registration – ***Main Campus Cafeteria*******

The 2017-2018 school year begins with Band Registration. All students must register for participation in the 2017-2018 LHS Band. All students and parents need to attend registration on Saturday, July 22nd in the Main Campus Cafeteria. This is the same process as last year. The schedule for Registration is different this year (by class) and is as follows:

All Drum Majors and Leadership Team will set up at 11:00am and work until 5:00pm.

Parents, we will need help on several important items at Registration as well as help with Band Uniform check-out. Please contact the Booster President if you can help – telephone number and email address are available on the band website.

Every person in the 2017-18 LHS Band will need to come to registration with a parent or guardian. If for some reason you cannot attend registration, please notify the Band Office by email at: **courtneyj@lisd.net** as early as possible. We ask that you make a payment on your Band Fee (\$100) at Registration. If there is a cause for concern, please let me know and we can work through it. The Band Fee covers such items as the show music and drill, Region Band fees, Solo/Ensemble entry and Accompanists fees, uniform socks, gloves, band t-shirt, music flip folders, bottled water for the year, clinicians for all bands, music purchase, as well as many other items listed in the budget. Please refer to the Band Budget for a complete listing. In addition to the first Band payment, **all Band students** will need to purchase new band shoes to be worn with the new Band Uniform for \$40. We will size for new shoes during the first week of school.

Please be prepared to do the following at Registration:

- 1) Turn in medical form complete with policy numbers and telephone numbers.
- 2) Check your address, telephone, and email information for accuracy.
- 3) Make a payment on your Band Fees - \$100
- 4) Pay for new Band Shoes - \$40
- 5) Purchase additional items such as yard signs, booster shirts, and instrument accessories **after** Band Fee payment, shoes and maintenance fees are paid.
- 6) Music and Arts Center will be on hand for those last minute items needed for Camp.

One additional item is regarding “**Summer Uniforms**”. Because of the warm Texas temperatures, we will not wear our Band Uniforms for the first few football games/events. The Summer Uniform consists of the Band T-Shirt (provided), Khaki Shorts (you provide – school appropriate), Tennis shoes, white socks (short socks) and brown/black belt. We will wear our Summer Uniforms for various events in the Fall, i.e. Fall Preview Show, early football games, Western Days Parade, etc.

We will also be again adding an afternoon rehearsal for all students auditioning for Region from Wind Symphony, Symphonic Winds and all interested students from Concert Band and Varsity Band. Please notice the new schedule below.

Tuesday, August 1: Everyone reports at 6:45am! (report to Main Campus Band Hall) – * Notice *** - We will be marching the first day of Camp.**

Students should remember to bring all of the following that apply to marching rehearsals:

- 1) Bring your own cooler with water only and your name clearly marked on it.
- 2) Wear tennis or athletic shoes with socks (**Boots, sandals, heels, etc. are not acceptable footwear at rehearsals.**)
- 3) Wear shorts and light colored t-shirts (loose fitting attire is the best).
- 4) Hats, sun glasses and sunscreen are a good idea.
- 5) Always have pencil and music in flip folders at rehearsals.
- 6) Always have drill coordinates at rehearsals (you will not need this the first day of rehearsal. We will provide the drill coordinate sheets and lanyards needed for rehearsals).
- 7) Always have your instrument and all parts in good working condition.
- 8) Eat breakfast every morning and drink water before coming to rehearsal. This will help you handle the August heat.
